

# **An Explanation from the Handicapped for the application for Waiver of Vehicles License Fee**

Item One. The accepting organization tax-exemption application for: the taxation organization where the applicant lives

Item Two. The conditions required:

- 1) If the handicapped has a driving license himself/herself:
  - i) A completed application
  - ii) Supporting Documents Required: A driving license, an operation license (the address of the car owner and the registered permanent residence of the applicant should be the same), the identification of the handicapped, the original ID card and the seal
  - iii) The vehicle should be owned by the applicant. If not, the registration for transfer of all previous tax (including the tax of this year). After the waiver is approved, you may apply to the tax office for refund.
  
- 2) If the handicapped doesn't have a driving license himself/herself:
  - i) A completed application
  - ii) Supporting Documents Required: An operation license (the address of the car owner and the registered permanent residence of the applicant should be the same), the identification of the handicapped, the household register, the original ID card and seal of the applicant and the car owner
  - iii) The car can be owned by the applicant or by the applicant's under the same household.
